Below is a list of birds spotted in fictional gardens throughout the UK over a period of one week. This data is for the purpose of supporting a maths lesson plan to teach students how to organise data, whilst learning about some of the most common British birds. Please note these are not real population figures.

- **John in London:** 50 Blackbirds, 12 robins, 40 Starlings, 35 Sparrows, 3 Blue tits, 3 Woodpigeon
- **Simon in Wales:** 20 Blackbirds, 15 Robins, 20 Starlings, 30 Sparrows, 10 Blue tits, 3 Great Tits
- **Linda in Scotland:** 18 Blue Tit, 25 Chaffinch, 30 Goldfinch
- **Catherine in the Midlands:** 30 Blackbirds, 25 Robins, 7 Sparrows, 5 Blue tits, 15 Goldfinches
- **Tim in the North-West:** 35 Blackbirds, 10 Robins, 12 Goldfinches
- **Jane in the North East:** 8 Robins, 19 Great Tits
- **Poppy in Yorkshire:** 3 Collared Dove, 3 Chaffinch, 21 Robins, 12 Goldfinches
- **Jack in the East of England:** 12 Blackbirds, 2 Robins, 12 Chaffinches, 15 Sparrows
- **Charlie in the South East:** 9 Blue Tits, 4 Great its, 5 Woodpigeon, 38 Starlings, 40 Sparrows
- **Jo in the South West:** 5 Chaffinch, 18 Robins, 2 Collared Dove, 50 Sparrows, 16 Blue tits
